OR

- b) DRAMA: John Ruganda: Shreds of Tenderness. (20mks)

Write a composition on the role of international community in fuelling war in Africa with reference to John Ruganda’s, ‘Shreds of Tenderness’.

OR

- c) THE NOVEL: Velma Pollard: Homestretch. (20mks)

Basing your illustrations on Velma Pollard’s novel Homestretch, write a composition on the impact of community service and patriotism in developing our nation.
