1. **Either**

2. **The compulsory set text.** (20mks)

Drawing your illustrations from Henrik Ibsen’s play An Enemy of the People, write a Composition outlining how Dr. Stockmann’s intentions to purify society are thwarted. (20mks)

3. **Either**

- (a) **The short story; Macmillan (Ed) Half a Day and Other Stories.**

Using illustrations from Saida Dirie Herzis short story “Government by Magic spell”

Write a composition on how bad governance affects people in a society. (20mks)

- (b) **Drama; Shreds of Tenderness – John Ruganda**

Odie is the villain in John Ruganda’s Shreds of Tenderness. Write an essay arguing for this statement. (20mks)

- (c) **The Novel: Velma Pollard Homestretch** write a composition on community service

As depicted in the novel Homestretch by Velma Pollard. (20mks)
